

PHYSICAL EDUCATION EXPECTATION AND GRADING COMPONENTS FOR GRADES 6 – 12

- Attendance and Participation
- Preparation
- Cooperation & Sportsmanship

- Test and Assignments

Attendance and Participation

Each student is expected to attend his/her assigned phys. ed. class. Loss of points from the Attendance/Participation component results after the second absence. No loss of points results from school related activities (band, field trips, tests, etc.). If classes need to be made up due to excessive absences arrangements can be made with your teacher.

Preparation

Students must change into gym clothes for each class. Shorts and/or sweatpants and T-shirt and/or sweatshirt are required. No "off-color" clothing or sports bras. Sneakers are required. Points will be deducted from the Preparation component for each day a student is not prepared. Students who do not "change up" will be expected to participate if they have sneakers and will walk, help out with class or do phys.ed. paper- work that is assigned to them. A letter may be sent home if a student forgets his/her clothes more than 3 times.

Cooperation & Sportsmanship

Students are expected to exhibit good sportsmanship, have a respectable attitude and cooperate with everyone in their phys. ed. class. They will accept students' differences in character, motor skills, age, sex, and knowledge and will be open to participate in new activities. The students will respect equipment and facilities.

Tests and Assignments

Students are responsible for the information presented in class. Many units may include a test, quiz, homework, and/or assignments.

Skill

Students are expected to work to their individual potential. The skill grade may be based on skill tests, rubrics, or teacher's subjectivity.

Illness or Injury

A note from home is needed for any minor injury or illness. If a student is to be excused from class longer than 3 consecutive classes, a doctor's note is necessary. Depending on the minor injury or illness and the activity planned in class, students may be asked to participate fully or in some other activity.

Locks and Lockers

Students will be issued a lock and locker. Junior High padlock must be returned at the end of the year. Keep your combination to yourself and lock items during class.
