You will choose the character that you are planning to study and have it approved by me. After that you will have until February 3rd, to complete the project in its entirety.

1. Write the name of the character you were awarded on the line provided.

2. Complete a model of the character with the following requirements: (50)

a. You are to use the mythology collection as your guide. (In other words, do not use the Internet or any movies to help you, unless they have modeled their creations after the collection.)

b. Remember to include details described in the collection itself (not the movies).

c. Complete the character using paper, clay, paper Maché, or any other material at your disposal, but it must be in 3D.

d. Use the models in the back of the room as a guide to decide how large to make your model.

(Hagrid is about 8 feet tall in the novels.) He is _____ inches tall as a model.

3. Three short paragraphs on your character that include the following:

a. Character's name and a detailed description of what they look like, their title, and any objects or animals they are associated with. (30)

b. Their origin story based on information from our anthology (collection) of myths. (60)

c. Write about any famous companies or groups that share their name with your character. Explain how the character's name fits well with the company, its products, or its mission statement. (35)

d. Remember to write your final draft on large index cards, in pencil with three paragraphs and proper GUM. (25)
