SUBJECT: SCHEDULING AND ROUTING

Bus routes are authorized by the Board of Education and any requests for a change must be submitted to the Superintendent or his/her designee.

The District will provide transportation for K-12 resident children to public, private or parochial schools they legally attend for distances up to fifteen (15) miles. This distance is measured from the Student's residence to the school, as per New York State Education Law.

In establishing bus routes, the administrative staff shall impose such reasonable limits on spacing, frequency of stops and/or central pick-up/drop-off points as will:

- a) Promote economy of operation;
- b) Make it possible for all buses to meet their time schedules;
- c) Promote student safety.
